What is Licence-Not-Required (LNR) Child Care?

Licence-Not-Required (LNR) child care is provided in the caregiver's own home. The caregiver can care for up to two children or one sibling group (brothers and sisters) in addition to those related to them by blood or marriage.

LNR child care providers are encouraged - but not required - to register with their local Child Care Resource and Referral Program (CCRR).

Some of the Benefits of registering as a LNR child care provider with the YMCA Child Care Resource and Referral (CCRR) include:

- Access to YMCA CCRR services that include: child care referrals, consultation, support and an opportunity to borrow from the toy and resource lending library.
- Increased Affordable Child Care Benefits (ACCB). The ACCB a family is eligible for increases if the LNR child care provider is registered with a CCRR.

How do I become a Registered LNR Child Care Provider?

Provincial requirements must be met before becoming a Registered LNR. For more information on these requirements please contact the YMCA CCRR and request an information session.
