How to Apply for an Aquatics Grant

- 1) Apply for a grant through the YMCA website (see QR codes below).
- 2) Register for the aquatics course you need through LIT Aquatics.

Bronze Medallion & Bronze Cross Combo	\$450	\$350	40 hours
Standard First Aid	\$175	\$150	14-16 hours
National Lifeguard	\$495	\$395	44 hours
YMCA Swim Instructor (YSI)	\$595	\$395	46-55** hours
Lifesaving Instructor (LSI)	\$560	\$360	28 hours

*Must provide proof of living in the city of Chilliwack or being a student in Chilliwack.

Note: Courses are usually taught on evenings, weekends, and during school breaks. Length of courses listed above do not include break times or wet/dry transitions.

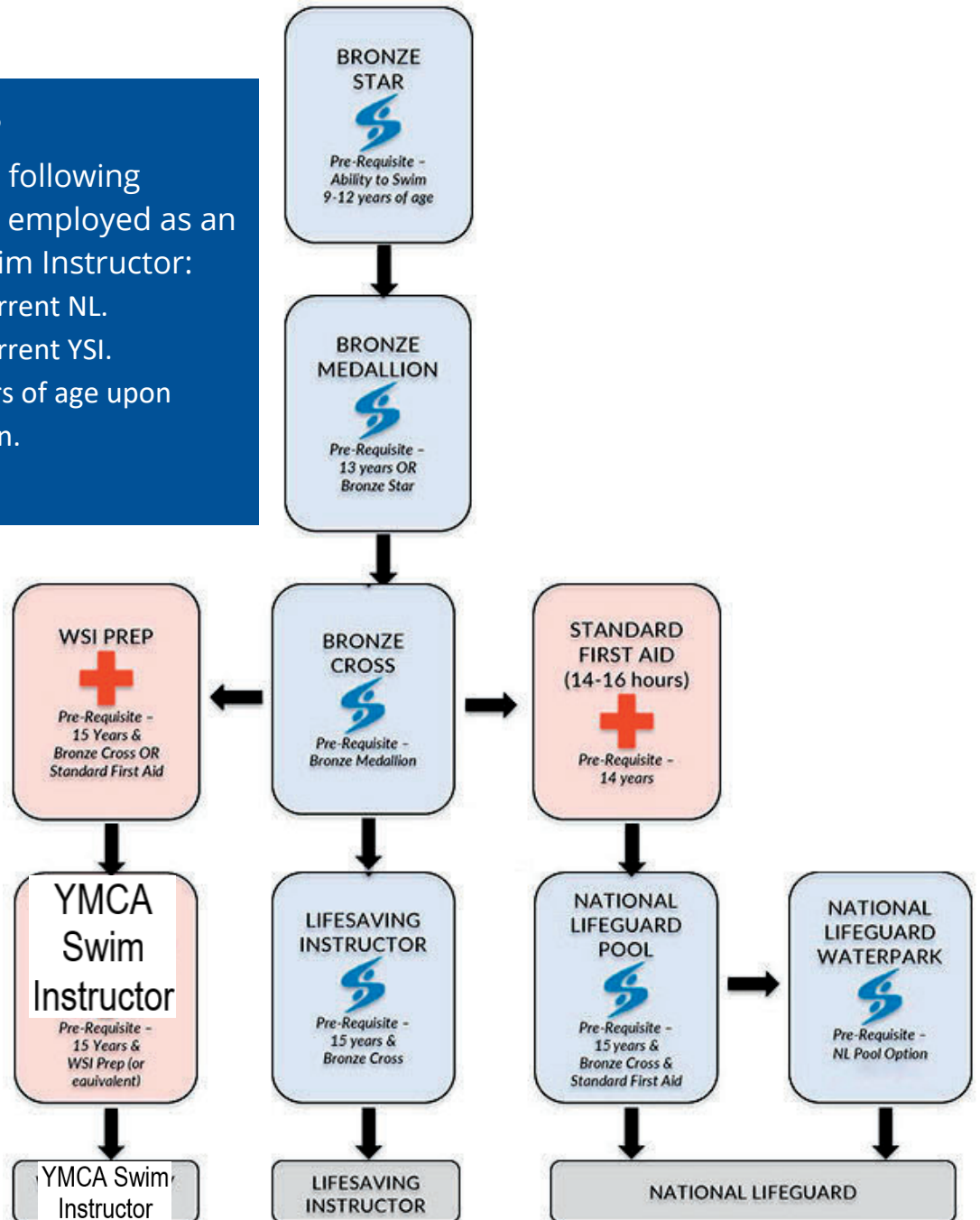


How to Become a Lifeguard

- Current SFA & Current NL.
- Current SFA & Current YSI.
- Minimum 15 years of age upon course completion.
